



Notes From Tim

HYMN: COME CHRISTIANS, JOIN TO SING!

A New Testament church should always be a singing Church, for the "sacred song" is the natural outpouring of joyous Christian hearts! Of all the world's religions, Christianity embodies the strongest singing faith. But singing should not be limited to our worship services; rather, it should also be the Christian's normal lifestyle.

Singing God's praises provides many important benefits to believers. There is the awareness that God is pleased when our voice is lifted in praise. "He who offers praise honors me" (Psalm 50:23). Then we learn many important spiritual truths and concepts when we sing. For many of us, our first awareness that God loves us and that He loves all the children of the world was gained through a song sung at our mother's knee, in a Sunday School nursery or class. Singing will also provide encouragement and comfort when we are experiencing periods of discouragement. A hymn will also come to mind and will be used of God to mend our fragile emotions. Also, singing is one of our best preparation for heaven. The Bible teaches that we will enjoy giving praise and singing throughout all eternity!

This hymn was originally titled "Come, Children, Join to Sing." It first appeared in 1843 in a collection Sacred Melodies for Sabbath Schools and Families, edited by the author of this text, Christian H. Bateman. Bateman served three Congregational churches in Scotland and England and then was ordained in the Anglican Church. The Hymn Tune: MADRID was taken from a Spanish melody.

Come, Christians, join to sing Alleluia! Amen! Loud praise to Christ our King; Alleluia! Amen! Let all, with heart and voice, Before his throne rejoice; Praise is we with grateful choice: Alleluia! Amen!

Come, lift your hearts on high; Alleluia! Amen! Let praises fill the sky; Alleluia! Amen! He is our guide and friend; on whom we can depend; His love shall never end: Alleluia! Amen!

Praise yet our Christ again; Alleluia! Amen! Life shall not end the strain; Alleluia! Amen! On heaven's joyful shore His goodness we'll adore, Singing forevermore: Alleluia! Amen!

Sunday, we will sing this hymn and others from around the world. It will be a time of profound Christian unity, marked by our shared celebration of the Lord's Supper. Jesus instituted the first such meal, World Communion Sunday is a helpful way in which Christ calls us together to celebrate the liturgy "in remembrance of me."
