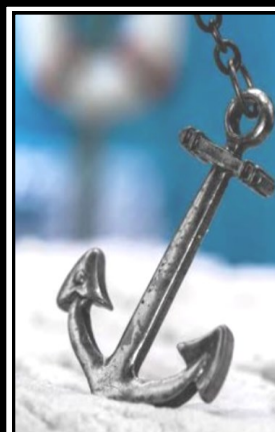

The Anchor Still Holds

For the past 18 months, it feels like life has been a constant raging storm with COVID. However, when the storms of life come, we as Christian have assurance that our Anchor in Jesus still holds. We can trust Him to meet our needs in spite of adversity. The disciples were filled with great fear when Jesus rebuked the wind and told the sea, “Peace Be still!” (Mark 4:39). Jesus displayed amazing supernatural power over nature. We learn, along with the disciples, that Jesus can be trusted in the storm. This is because He is sovereign.

God’s sovereignty is described in Psalm 24:1-2: “The earth is the LORD’s, and everything in it, the world, and all who live in it; for He founded it on the seas and established it on the waters.” God is in perfect control of the universe. He is involved in *everything* in this world and is directing **all** things, people, nature, etc. to fulfill His divine purposes. When facing the storms of life, understanding the sovereignty of our amazing God is essential.

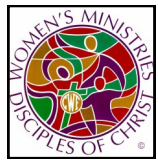
The disciples showed us both what to do and what not to do. They were right to go to Jesus in the storm. However, they fell short because they went to Him in fear and doubt. Jesus wanted them to have faith in Him in the midst of the terrible storm. In Philippians 4:5-6, we are told how to replace our fear and anxiety with prayer, supplication, and thanksgiving. We are then released from the grip of fear and anxiety when we thank Him for His sovereign power and purpose for the storms. We can trust His promise that His peace will guard our hearts and minds so that we will not be fearful or anxious during any storm (Phil. 4:7).

The storms of life are a part of God’s sanctification plan, revealing our hearts, and growing us into His image. *Do not let the difficult storms become bigger than the promises of Jesus*. He promises to be with us through any storm that He allows in our lives (Isa. 43:2). He is our refuge and deliverer. ~tc

During the month of September, we will be collecting **Pasta** for Crisis Control. Thank you, to everyone who support this wonderful ministry regularly. You are a blessing!

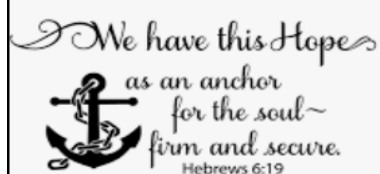
